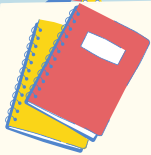

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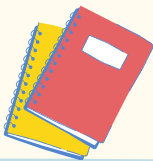
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INTRODUCTION

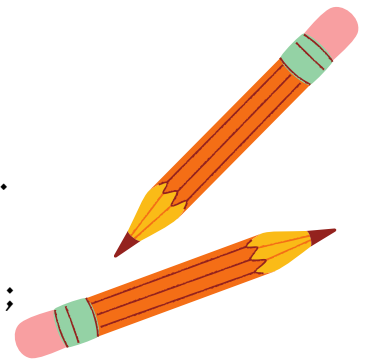
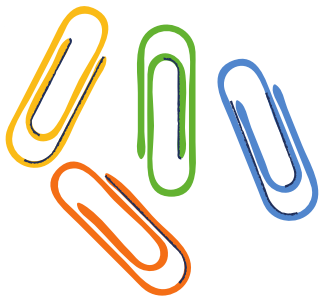
EACH day is a NEW BEGINNING

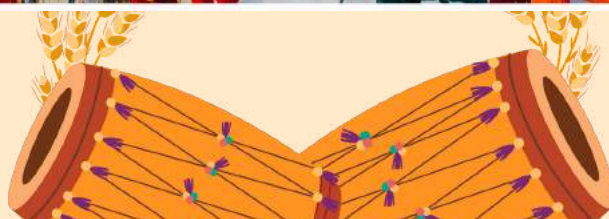

Grammar Tips

Hello to one and all!

Here are some important Grammar Tips for you to use proper Grammar Skills in your daily conversation with English Speaking People. I will be giving a few tips in our monthly magazine on how to rectify your sentences without using heavy Grammar. Hope it will help you in your daily conversation.

Wrong usage: I will make them to read story books. / I will make them to write the answer.

Correct usage: I will make them read story books. / I will make them write the answer.

Note: We do not use "to" with the verbs "read / write" or any other verb when we use the word "Make"

Wrong usage: I will let the children to play games. / He will let her to play the piano.

Correct usage: I will let the children play games. / He will let her play the piano.

Note: Here "Let" means "Allow" We do not use "to" with the verb "play" or any other verb when we use the word "Let"

Reason: "to read, to write, to play, to eat, to drink etc. are known as Infinitive Verbs because they take the word "to" before them and can be used with singular and plural Nouns and Pronouns.

Examples: The girl likes to dance. / The girls like to dance.

Note: Here "like" is the Main Verb and is restricted by Noun Number "girl and girls" So for girl we use likes and for girls we use like. But "to dance" is not restricted by any of them. The verb used without "to" is known as "Bare Infinitive"
